COMMITTEE REPORTS: None

STAFF REPORT: Mr. Kelly reports the following:

<u>Alcoa</u>: Received an agreement from the New York State Department of Transportation for the 2021 Passenger and Freight Rail Assistance Program grant award for the Alcoa Track Rehabilitation and Grade Crossing Safety Improvement Project.

<u>Canexsys Networks Inc.</u>: The company has set up operations in the 100 Paterson Street Building in Ogdensburg and phase 2 improvements are underway.

<u>Canton Industrial Building</u>: LED lights are being replaced and installed today at the Canton Industrial Building, in part through a grant awarded by National Grid.

Marketing: As part of the Come Here/Come Back Here campaign, we renewed our ad in the latest edition of the St. Lawrence County Chamber of Commerce's Relocation and Visitor Guide. We also hosted a meeting with about a half dozen realtors in St. Lawrence County to bring awareness about the services we offer, and how we can partner our efforts with the local agencies to attract more people and businesses to the county. Additionally, we applied to Empire State Development for Global NY Grant assistance that, if approved, will help obtain funds to support our marketing efforts in Canada next year. In response to Mr. McMahon's question concerning the amount requested in the application, Mr. Kelly notes that approximately \$53,500 was requested.

<u>Unemployment and Workforce</u>: Business Resource Connections spotlighting programs at each of the three BOCES Tech Centers will begin in December with Southwest Tech (in Fowler), Seaway Tech (Norwood) in January, and Northwest Tech (Ogdensburg) in February. This is a great way for us to connect local companies with the programs available at BOCES, to help develop a workforce pipeline for businesses by introducing them to services offered at the tech centers, and to see first-hand the nature of each of the programs through student led tours.

NYS Authorities Budget Office: As a refresher, some staff members attended the ABO and PARIS report training sessions at the IDA Fall Academy in Utica earlier this month.

In January, the St. Lawrence County Chamber of Commerce will host the 2023 FISU World University Games. Staff attended a meeting with local leaders, businesses and community members last week to discuss preparation for this event which is expected to draw people from all over the world.

AUTHORIZING ALLOCATIONS THROUGH THE ST LAWRENCE COUNTY AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND TOURISM FUNDING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2022, the St. Lawrence County Board of Legislators approved accepting the County's American Rescue Plan Act ("ARPA") Committee's recommendation for the portion of American Rescue Plan Act Funds to be administered by the St. Lawrence County Industrial Development Agency ("IDA"), and

WHEREAS, the Board of Legislators declared that "economic development and tourism are essential to improving the services and activities available in St. Lawrence County" and allocated \$2,900,000 in ARPA funds to be distributed through the St. Lawrence County Industrial Development Agency ("IDA") to organizations impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, and

WHEREAS, these recommendations included authorizing funds for Economic Development and Tourism as allowed within the scope of the ARPA Final Rule, and

WHEREAS, St. Lawrence County and the IDA have an existing economic development services agreement through which the IDA provides economic development services for the County and the allocation of these funds by the IDA is being performed within the scope of this existing economic development services agreement, and

WHEREAS, the St. Lawrence County Industrial Development Agency is now accepting applications for ARPA funding assistance,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the St. Lawrence County Industrial Development Agency, having exercised its own due diligence in the matter, authorizes the allocation of ARPA funds in the amounts as described in the attached document (Exhibit A), and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the St. Lawrence County Industrial Development Agency authorizes the creation, execution and/or delivery of any and all documents and/or budget accounts that may be required to effectuate the transactions contemplated by this resolution.
